*Trauma Informed Early Intervention, Early Childhood Special Education, & Social Work*

Project T13 will prepare 24 full-time masters students in early intervention (EI), early childhood special education (ECSE), or school social work (SSW) who have expertise in:

- supporting the social emotional development
- using trauma-informed supports
- providing responsive, evidence-based services to young children (birth through five) with delays or disabilities and their families.

Project T13 students will acquire competencies via coursework, a trauma-informed practice seminar, and multi-disciplinary practicum and traineeship experiences. Full-time students funded through Project T13 will receive:

- Competitive monthly stipends
- Tuition waiver
- A waiver of most university fees
